General Guidelines

Dress Code: Participants should wear tournament dress as described in Section III of the NCFCA Qualifying Tournament Participation General Rules. The spirit of the dress code is modesty and professionalism with the intent to glorify Christ. Entrants should view this document prior to attending the round robin. It can be found at www.ncfca.org.

Competitor Eligibility: Any homeschooled student who will be between the ages of 12 and 18 on January 1, 2010 may participate.

Entry Procedure: Each entrant from the same household must complete separate registration forms. The registration form must be complete and mailed with a check payable to Shirley Rowe. **There is limited space available. Entries will not be accepted after all the slots are filled.**

Entry deadline: Entries postmarked after November 7, 2009 may not be accepted. If space is available after this date, a late registration fee will apply.

Speech Events Offered: Apologetics, Dramatic Interpretation, Duo Interpretation, Extemporaneous, Humorous Interpretation, Illustrated Oratory, Impromptu, Original Oratory, and Persuasive. A maximum of five events may be entered.

Apologetics: In order to encourage students who are just getting started on apologetics files, all questions at this tournament will be from Category 5: The Person of Christ.

Entry Fees: \$5.00 per student for basic registration and then \$5.00 per event entered. Please fill out the registration form information for each entrant, and include a check payable to Shirley Rowe.

Scripts: A penalty of one rank will be given for the use of a script in a prepared event.

Time limits: No time signals are given for platform or interpretive speeches, but if your speech is three minutes over the maximum time limit, the judges in the room will call time. This is so rounds can be completed in a timely manner. Please check the maximum time limit for your event (available at www.ncfca.org) and cut your speech accordingly.

Judges and Timekeepers: We are attempting to find as many from the community as possible to be judges for our round robin. However, it is often necessary to ask parents to step in as judges. Therefore, we request that every parent and chaperone be available to judge and/or be a timekeeper. Judges will receive a free lunch. There will be a judges' orientation at 8:30 am for the morning round and at 1:00 pm for the afternoon round. Judges must attend an orientation session before they will be given their judging assignments. Judges need to check in at the judges' table. Timekeepers should check in at the timekeepers' table.

Competitor Responsibility: Each entrant is asked to come with an attitude for learning and an excitement for glorifying God. With this in mind we ask that each entrant and attendee be good stewards of the facility on loan to us by Trinity Baptist Church.

Lunch: A pizza lunch will be provided on Saturday IF you have signed up and included your payment with your registration form.

Each entrant should bring:

- Water bottle (no drinks except water outside of Fellowship Hall)
- A sack lunch if you are not prepaying for the pizza lunch
